	Students study towards AQA Level 1 Certificate (Foundation Certificate of Secondary Education (FCSE)) Modern Foreign Languages in German and submit their portfolio of three units from different themes for accreditation in May of Year 13. All assessments for each unit – one for each of the skill areas of listening, speaking, reading and writing – are taken when the students are ready for them typically this COULD be
